### THE PORT

No address better reflects the creative spirit of this vibrant city than **Le Port** (☎ 026 321 22 26; [www.leport.ch](http://www.leport.ch); Planche-Inférieure 5; 🕒 10am-11pm Tue-Sun).

Squirrelled away in a former gas warehouse on the banks of the River Sarine, the Port bursts with energy. On summer days Fribourgeois hang out on its tree-shaded terrace on the river banks between tai chi classes, visits to pop-up *ateliers* (workshops) and seasonal lunch-time platters (Sfr20) of locally cured meats and homegrown veg. Come dark – once the last tango class has left the dance floor – live bands, film screenings, dance nights and discos move in.
